Project Description

Appalachian State University is seeking design services for a new indoor batting facility for Baseball. The project scope includes the erection of a new Pre-Engineered Metal Building approximately 34' x 60' to house indoor baseball training. Some existing storm drains and piping will be removed to make room for the building pad. The building is intended to be heated and illuminated. The Owner will finish with turf flooring outside of the contract for construction. Some preliminary feasibility work has been completed on this project and will be furnished to the selected firm.

The project will be administered as a General Administration formal project. Additional project requirements will be given to the selected firm.

The total project budget is \$749,000.

- 4. Adequate staff and proposed team who have similar project experience.
- 5. Current workload and State projects awarded.
- 6. Proposed commissioning approach or methodology

- 7. Owner's Representative capabilities
- 8. Record of successfully-completed projects without major legal or technical problems
- 9. Other factors which may be appropriate for the project
